

**THINK GREEN~ SAVE & RE-USE ANY GENTLY USED  
SUPPLIES AND SAVE \$\$\$\$  
Art Supplies Needed for 2011-2012  
Grades: K-5**

1. **SMOCK-Students need to wear an apron or old shirt to be allowed to participate in art.** They should come already dressed to perform work –  
NO EXCEPTIONS!
2. (10) **Sharpened, please ☺** #2 pencils
3. 2 personal erasers
4. Wooden ruler – NO rubber/bendable, please.
5. 1 Box colored pencils –**Sharpened, please. ☺**
6. Set of (10) thin and/or thick tipped colored markers
7. (1) Pack 16-24 Crayons)
8. Elmer's glue – 1 bottle, + 1 glue stick
9. (1) sharp-pointed scissors – appropriately sized
10. Large Clear 2-Gal Zippered (Zip-Lock) Hefty Bag ( to store art kit supplies)
11. (1) Personal drawing book/tablet
12. (1 each) fine black Sharpie marker and ultra fine black Sharpie marker

For the beginning of the year, I'd like students in **K-1st** with last names **A-M** to bring 1 roll of paper towels, last names **N-U** to bring 1 container of baby wipes and **V-Z** to bring 1 box of tissues.

Note: Use the clear Zip-Lock to create a small art tool-kit to be stored in cubbies or tubs in homeroom – **The art kit should be SEPARATE from core supplies.** Label everything with names using permanent markers and **bring toolkit to every art class.**

Every child needs to come to art class wearing a smock over his or her uniform. NO EXCEPTIONS. Children are much freer to express themselves when unencumbered by worries about messiness. We plan to get messy and have fun while learning, please send in an old t-shirt or button down with sleeves cut appropriately and have the children keep them at school in cubbies. Do not forget to have kids bring shirts home for laundering periodically!
